The Latino Tech™ “The Future of Work Summit,” powered by Codella.org at Hialeah Gardens High School on December 14th, will inspire participants to dream big and be prepared for opportunity as they hear from a roster of nationally recognized female tech leaders who will show them what their jobs look like and what it took to get there.

Keynote speaker Dr. Margaret Z. Dominguez, an Optical Engineer from NASA Goddard Space Flight Center in Maryland, will share what it took for her to make it to NASA from her hometown in Mexico and the lessons learned on her journey.

According to the National Science Foundation, approximately seventy percent of the population is largely underrepresented or missing from the field of computer science. Although women hold 57% of all professional occupations, they hold only 26% of all computing occupations. The numbers are even lower for women of color. Latinas and black women hold only 1% and 3% of these jobs respectively.

Latino Tech™ wants to make sure that all underserved female students understand what the new work ecosystem requires, how they can access pathways to new careers, as well as how to navigate a mostly confusing, cluttered and chaotic, continually shifting skills-based universe.

In a rapidly evolving tech-centric labor market where workers constantly need to up their skills and companies struggle to find qualified candidates, it is critical that students are familiar with new occupational categories, as digitalization, automation, and advances in artificial intelligence disrupt the world of work at a faster rate and a larger scale than any other labor shift in history.

Latino Tech™ will be offering 10 interactive learning workshops curated by profession to specifically communicate the knowledge and skills the future job seekers will need to acquire as they become career-ready.
